

COILLTE APPORVED CHAINSAW / TREE FELLING TRAINING

This course is designed for safe working practices with Chainsaws. The course is designed to meet the requirements for employee safety under the Safety Health & Welfare at Work Act, 1989.

Course Aim

To enable candidates to correctly use chainsaw equipment either on site or for the purpose of felling trees.

Objectives

1. Cut trees up to guide bar length.
2. Cross-cutting. Snedding (debranching).
3. Split level cuts.
4. Taking down of hung-up trees
5. An outline of P.P.E gear required in this area.
6. Presentation of Material
7. General Chainsaw Maintenance.
8. Chain Sharpening.
9. Carburettor Training

Duration: 3 to 5 days

No of Delegates: 6 Maximum per course.

3 Day Course: Cross Cutting can be held on site or at Coillte's Premises

5 Day Course: Tree Felling can be held on site or at Coillte's Premises

Certification: On successful completion of this course Shorcontrol Safety will issue a Coillte Certificates to each delegate, which are valid for 3 years.
