

## **C – 2 THE SUPERVISING OF RISK DURING CONFINED SPACES WORKING**

Participants attending this programme will be assessed on a theory and practical basis and nationally approved certification will be awarded. The certification lasts for 3 years but refresher training may be required within the 3 year period depending on the frequency of confined spaces working or if there have been changes in work methods, safety procedures or equipment. – Section 6.2.1., 6.2.7.7.2 and 7.5 of The Confined Spaces code of practice S.I No. 218 of 2001.

- Practical use of short term breathing apparatus-simulation facility.
- Practical self rescue – simulation facility
- Written assessment – classroom
- Practical assessment – simulation facility

**Duration:** This course is for duration of four days.

**No. of Delegates:** 10 maximum per course

**Certifications:** On successful completion of this course, a FÁS FETAC Certificate will be issued to each delegate, which is valid for 3 years.
