

PREFABRICATED ALUMINIUM MOBILE **ACCESS TOWER TRAINING**

This programme is for any person, operative or manager, who needs certification for the use of mobile access towers.

Course Aim

This course aims to train the participants in the safe Assembly, Use & Disassembly of Mobile Access Towers. (MAT's)

Course Content

Module One: Classroom

- Legislation
- Safety at Heights
- Identification / Inspection of tower components
- Physics that govern mobile towers
- Safe use of mobile towers
- Safe erection of mobile towers through a simulated computer program.

Module Two: Practical

- Disassemble a D/W span MAT
- Assemble a 14ft platform height D/W span MAT
- Relocate a D/W span tower against a wall or on uneven ground
- Disassemble 14ft D/W span MAT
- Demonstration is then given on a stairladder MAT (trainer)
- Disassemble and assembly of stairladder MAT

Evaluation / Examination

During the practical session all trainees are assessed on their knowledge and capabilities of assembling and disassembling MAT's. Then they will all return to classroom for written examinations.

Duration: One day

No. of Delegates: 8 maximum per course

Certification: On successful completion of this course, a PASMA (Prefabricated Access Suppliers' and Manufacturers' Association) Certificate will be issued to each delegate, which is valid for 3 years.
